Kaleen Primary School will be celebrating World Environment Day, this **Friday 7 June**.

As part of observing World Environment Day, Kaleen Primary School students and staff are invited to wear some type of *weather appropriate attire* to show their support for the environment. **Students may like to wear clothing which shows an international or Australian animal or place which is special to them. Other options cleverly suggested by our students, are to draw or locate a picture of their favourite endangered animal and attach it to their clothing or bring in a book or small labelled toy that represents an endangered animal. There will be no donations of money required.**

Kaleen Primary School will also be celebrating World Environment Day by holding a lunch time movie session on both Friday 7 June and Friday 14 June. Students can come to the library for no cost and view the movie *Over the Hedge*. *Over the Hedge* is a humorous animated movie that explores how wild animals are impacted by their loss of habitat to humans.

During Sustainability lessons, students will also create a 'Wanted Poster' to help protect the preferred endangered animal (an Australian or international species) of their choice. This poster will constitute part of the annual poster design competition we hold for 'World Environment Day'.
