What: The KPS Read-a-Thon is a 'Fun-raising' event for the whole school. Students from Preschool through to Year 6 are encouraged to participate by reading as many books as they can.



Students will receive a form to record all of the books they read during the 6 weeks. At the end of the Read-a-Thon, each student will submit the total number of books they read into a Google form (this link will be sent out closer to the closing date). Each student who participates will receive an automatic entry in the draw to win some fabulous prizes.

When: The Read-a-Thon will start on **Monday 15 June (Term 2 Week 8)** and finish on **Friday 24 July (Term 3 Week 1)**.



Why: The purpose of the Read-a-Thon is to encourage and promote the love of reading throughout the community.



Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Are there any rules on the books that are read for the Read-a-Thon?

A: Students are encouraged to read a variety of age appropriate books. It absolutely counts if books are read to or read with someone as well as being **read** independently.

Q: What if we are already involved in another reading Challenge such as The Chief Ministers Reading Challenge?

A: All books that you read for the Read-a-Thon can be included in any other challenges you are currently participating in. It is a win, win!

Q: How do we donate money to the P&C for the 'Fun-raiser'?

A: It is not a requirement to donate any money to the P&C, however it is appreciated if you are able to spare some change. You can bring a gold coin donation on the final day of the Read-a-Thon (Friday 25 July) or you can transfer donations into the P&C bank account.
